**CREATE article for European Psychologist**

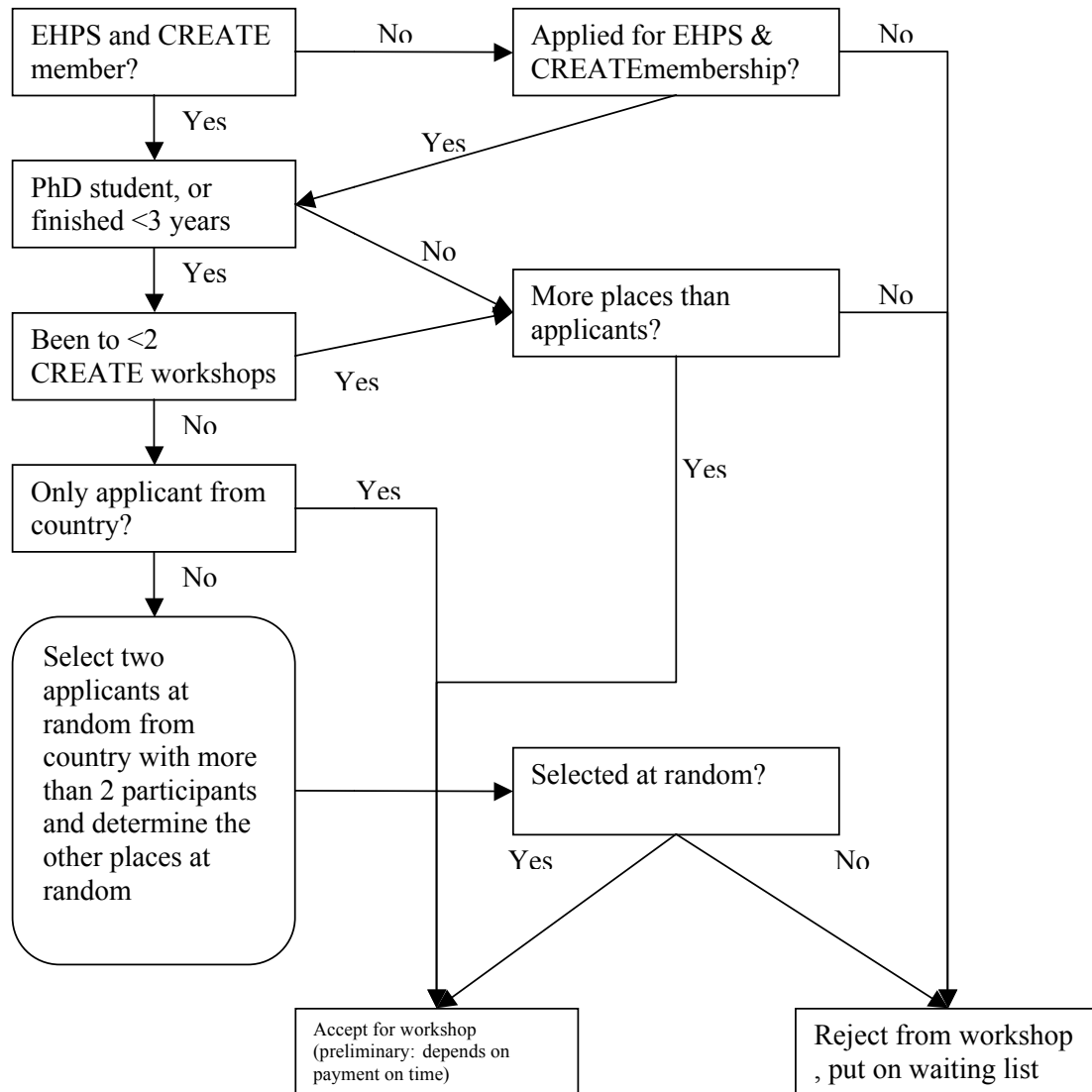
Zoe Stavri will write a short review on this year's CREATE workshop which will be published in the next issue of the European Psychologist.

**CREATE networking activities**

Apart from the CREATE webbase where everyone can register with their name and research interests there is a Facebook group (CREATErs) that everybody is welcome to join and keep updated on all ongoing activities.

**Application procedure for workshop**

1. Each facilitator can invite one participant (that fulfills the criteria: EHPS and CREATE Member, PhD student, not more than 2 previous workshops)
2. from countries with only one applicant, this applicant is selected
3. in the random selection, in the first step we ensure 2 workshop places for each country (with more than one application) by drawing randomly two applicants within a country
4. only at this final step we carried out a fully random selection with all applicants in the same pool.
5. Overall number depends on the facilitators



**Application/selection procedure for becoming a member of the CREATE OC**

The CREATE organisers are elected by the members of the CREATE database for a period of at least two years. Elections will take place via an online platform. Applications from a wide variety of countries are encouraged, the CREATE database will be notified in time whenever new elections take place. In case there are not enough applications from different countries, more than two CREATE organisers can be from the same country (as was the case in this year's elections).
